Time Schedule for the SITM Conference 2022

Organized by Charles University, Prague, and the Centre for Classical Studies at the Institute of Philosophy, Czech Academy of Sciences:

1st October, 2021: deadline for **proposals for performances**. The proposals will be discussed individually with each applicant in order to find a suitable way of financing the production. Please, contact us for further information.

Mid-October: information about the registration fees

1st November, 2021: deadline for the **proposal for papers and workshops**. Please, submit the proposals in the online form below (you will be asked to give your name, e-mail address, affiliation, title of the paper/workshop, and a 100-word summary).

15th January, 2022: feed-back on the **acceptance of the proposals**.

15th April, 2022: **online-publication** of the papers in full length (in the members-area of the SITM website).

1st May, 2022: feed-back on whether the **travel costs** for performing students can be fully refunded by the conference organisation.

1st June, 2022: deadline for **registration without a presentation**.

18 – 21 July, 2022: **Conference**. Please be reminded that the papers are not given in full, but a 10 minute summary is presented to the audience who have read the paper.

Information concerning COVID-19:

In order to ensure that (future) members of SITM are able to attend the event even in the case of constraints arising from the epidemiological situation, the programme will be held in a hybrid form, enabling those unable to join in person to present their papers and take part in discussions online.

All necessary measures will be taken to prevent the spread of COVID-19 during the event, especially regular disinfection of surfaces, distancing measures, the necessity to cover one's mouth and nose during the official programme, and availability of disinfection at the conference facilities.
